Information and advice for participants

To come to France

First, of course, check that you have a valid passport. The French government does not require a visa of anyone from a Common Market country, the United States or Canada, for a period of less than three months. If you are not a citizen of one of these countries, or if you wish to stay in France longer than three months, you must apply for a visa at a French consulate (addresses available at any travel agency).

In Paris, fast trains for Avignon (called "TGV") leave from the "Gare de Lyon" train station in the city, or directly from "Roissy Charles-De-Gaulle" airport.

Arrival

Monday.

To come to Saint Victor la Coste by bus from TGV train station, there are shuttles trains from TGV station to Avignon center. Once at Avignon center, go to the bus station right next and take the bus service "Edgard" line B23 direction Bagnols sur Cèze, bus stop "écoles" in Saint Victor la Coste. You can refer Edgard web page <http://www.edgard-transport.fr/>. Many buses, 1.60€.

If you come by car from Avignon, follow the way to Bagnols sur Cèze, Saint Laurent des Arbres and Saint Victor la Coste.

Departure

Saturday morning.

Clothing and packing

You must bring your own towels. Sheets, pillows and blankets are provided.

Travel light!!! By all means, luggage should be limited to what you can easily carry alone.

For laundry at the site, there are no machines available; volunteers hand wash as necessary in large sinks, and clothes dry quickly on lines outside. **A pocket flashlight can be handy.**

French electrical current is 220 volt, so a voltage converter (and adapter – French outlets have round holes) is necessary to use any North American appliance.

Please note the request that, to respect the privacy of all taking part, volunteers not make videos on the site.

You should change at least a small amount of pocket money before coming to the village the first day, since there are no banks there.
