Activity and technique

Volunteer Workshop from 4 June to 28 août 2018

More than 5,000 volunteers worked to save this village. La Sabranenque continues this movement by working on environmental space and on suspended gardens as well as on paved roads. The medieval village, with its stone houses, courtyards and alleys, illuminates with the vibrant light of Provence. The beauty and the peace are as pre-

The works will take place on the access road to the castle and in the streets of the old village

Technical:

Stones are used which naturally have a flat face that will be on the surface, pressed vertically into the ground and blocked against each other

Ancestral technique inexpensive, perennial, little maintenance. It was the technique of the Romans for their roads, but here we use smaller stones because there are no vehicles that circulate.

Gardening systems

The medieval village is built on the slope of the hill. The gardens are terraced

Technical; Construction or consolidation of dry stone walls, vertical construction without vertical but without mortar which requires special attention. The walls which rest on the slopes are made of stones mounted on top of each other and wedged by small stones. Plantations of local species.

Along the hill on which the fortress stands, there are witnesses of fortifications or old houses which are reduced to vestiges that the vegetation covers in part. La Sabranenque wishes to safeguard these vestiges to prevent their disappearance.
